01. ELIGIBILITY

Professionals

The 2026 Aegean Messinia Pro-Am Individual Professional event will be open to all PGA Members and trainees as recognised by their National PGA, as well as any individual that has professional status (i.e. has given up their Amateur Status as per the Rules of Amateur Status, published by the R&A and the USGA, effective 01 January 2022). Any doubts as to eligibility will be decided by the CPG Board of Directors whose decision will be final.

Amateurs

Amateur participants must be in possession of a valid handicap certificate.

03. REGISTRATIONS AND PROFESSIONAL BRIEFING

CPG Registration:

Online team registration via Golf Genius for Professionals **MUST** be completed before 10:00hrs (local time) on Wednesday June 24, 2026, at <https://cp.golf/4eLnSny>.

It is the Professional's responsibility to confirm their Amateurs current handicap upon registration and **MUST** provide an updated handicap certificate, dated within two weeks of the start of the event, via <https://cp.golf/handicaps> or provided to the CPG via email or WhatsApp as a print-out or as a document/image.



Failure to do so will result in the amateur playing off a handicap of 0.0.

On Site registration desks will be operational from Tuesday June 23 in the **House of Events**. All players are required to register by 10:00hrs (local time) on Wednesday June 24.

There will be a Professional Briefing at 19:00 on Wednesday June 24 in the 1827 Bar - attendance is mandatory for all professionals. Failure to attend will result in a fine of €100.00

Data Use:

All participants agree that their personal data may be given to third parties for reasons related to timing, results' ranking and announcement on the internet as well as for the provision of any promotion, offer, gifts and trophies. Personal data of the participants required during the registration procedure are stored and will be used for purposes related to the staging of the event and for inclusion within relevant CPG communications (unless otherwise opted in to). By submitting an entry form, each participant consents to the storing of his/her personal data and its use for the purposes of the event. Participants can unsubscribe from any CPG communication at any time.

Participants consent to the use of their image during the event by the organisers, sponsors, or other partners of the event for promotional purposes, with no right to claim full or partial compensation for that reason.

04. CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The event will be played under The R&A Rules of Golf, CPG Tournament Regulations, 2026 CPG Conditions of Competition and the local rules for The Dunes Course, The Hills Course and International Olympic Academy Course, as determined by the CPG Tournament Director. All conditions of play and format points are subject to change.

Professional Competition:

The Professionals will compete in a 54-hole individual Strokeplay competition.

Team Competition:

Teams (consisting of 1 Professional and 3 Amateurs) will compete in a 54-hole Stableford competition with the best two scores from the team of four to count on each hole.

The handicap index limit is 28 for men and 36 ladies. This handicap index will be sloped first, then reduced to a 75% allowance. The resulting playing handicap will also be limited to 28 for men and 36 for ladies. The World Handicapping System (WHS) will apply to the tournament, and each amateur will play from the applicable playing handicap.

Prizes (all subject to change):

Amateurs

- Overall team prizes will be awarded in the 54-Hole Pro-Am to the leading four teams
- Nearest the Pin (male amateurs); Nearest the Pin (female amateurs);
- Longest Drive (male amateurs); Longest Drive (female amateurs)
- In the event of a tie in the Pro-Am category, prizes will be determined by a card countback based on the scores achieved over the last 18 holes, then 9, 6, 3, and last hole.

Professionals

- Prize Fund - The Professional Prize Fund is €64,000 based on 59 teams competing in the Pro-Am. The Prize Fund is subject to change, and a CPG 6% Levy.
- Nearest the Pin & Longest Drive
- Hole in One Car – Hole 10 Dunes.



Any disputes regarding the interpretation of these Conditions of Competition will be settled by the CPG Tournament Director in consultation with Aegean Airlines and Costa Navarino and will be binding.

In the event of a tie in the Professional tournament there will be a sudden death play-off, which will take place immediately after all players have confirmed their scores following Round 3. The play-off will take place on The Dunes Course and the holes that will be used will be confirmed on the tournament noticeboard.

05. DRAWS

The starting times for all rounds of the Pro-Am will be published on the noticeboards in the Costa Navarino House of Events and sent by email by 14.00hrs on Wednesday, June 24.

Teams will play a different course each day. Please ensure that you make a note of your tee time and which of the courses you are playing in each round.

Teams MUST remain in the same flight for the duration of the tournament.

NOTE: No changes to the draw will be permitted once they are posted and the decision of the CPG Tournament Director will be final.

06. STARTING & TEES

All competitors are required to be at their starting tee **10 minutes prior to their start time**. This is to allow the starter to provide pin positions, local rules and additional information to each team. This also ensures that all team members are present and able to start on time.

NOTE: Female Professionals will play from a course that is not shorter than 10-14% shorter than the total course yardage of the course played by the male Professionals. The Tournament Director will vary the tees as necessary to ensure the fairness of the courses and the event.

Female amateurs and juniors will play from the red tees.

Male Amateurs that are 55 years or older are permitted to play from the red tees on all 3 courses (using the men's red slope). Male Professionals that are 55 years or older are permitted to play from the yellow tees on all 3 courses. If you require either of these requests, please send an e-mail to aw@cpg.golf by no later than 12:00 hours on Wednesday June 24, 2026

Missing team members including the PGA Professional may be subject to penalty if the team in question fails to meet the points highlighted in 20.1 of the CPG tournament Regulations.

NOTE: When both Professional and the team are subject to a two-stroke penalty for lateness on the tee, the team total for the first hole will be increased by two shots prior to any penalty being added to the Professional's individual score for that hole.

07. BUGGIES

All competitors will be permitted to ride in buggies for the practice rounds and the tournament rounds of the Pro-Am.

08. RECORDING OF SCORES

Both the Professional and 1 Amateur from each team will record scores using the Golf Genius app. Please ensure you have both downloaded the app on your smartphone in advance of the tournament. The Professional will record their own score and all amateur scores. The amateur team member will be responsible for marking and signing for the Professional's scores.

All scores **MUST** be recorded with a CPG Official immediately after play. Players **MUST** visit the Scoring Area relevant to the course they played straight after play. Failure to do so can result in disqualification.



09. RULINGS & DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE

There will be a CPG Rules Official on each course to deal with any disputes. If, however, there is no Rules Official available the player may invoke Rule 20.1c(3) (two ball rule). The player must nominate the ball with which he wants to score, should the rules permit, and report the facts to a CPG Official immediately after the conclusion of play. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.

10. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

All competitors will be permitted to use distance-measuring devices to measure **distance only**. If a player has any doubt as to whether a device is conforming, they should seek the advice of a CPG official.

11. PACE OF PLAY POLICY

For everyone's enjoyment, we ask each team to "keep up with the team in front, and not just in front of the team behind". **If a player is not going to score on a hole, he/she is requested to please "pick up"**. Set Pace of Play timing will be enforced on all courses.

It will be the Professional's responsibility to ensure that the team's pace of play adheres to the guidelines of the Tournament Director. A pace of play policy will be published for each course and **MUST** be followed by all participants.

12. BAD WEATHER / PLAY FORESHORTENED OR CANCELLED

In the event of bad weather and an overall result not being possible, the overall result will be decided over completed rounds.

All players should make themselves aware of the Suspension of Play Policy, which can be found on the CPG Hard Card – Section A11. In all instances when there is a threat of lightning the player should put their own safety first and seek shelter as soon as possible.

In the event of unforeseen circumstances any decision made by the CPG in consultation with Aegean Airlines and Costa Navarino will be binding.

13. DRESS REGULATIONS

Normal Golf clothing is to be worn during the tournament or the equivalent after golf. Professionals are permitted to wear shorts throughout the practice and tournament rounds.

Dress code will be indicated for each advertised function.

14. CURRENCY

The local currency is Euro (EUR).
